HPSG treatment of Polish past tense agreement markers (based on Crysmann (2006))

Past tense agreement marker

- realizes subj-verb agreement in 1st- and 2ndperson in past tense
- can attach directly right-adjacent to verbal participle or float to the left
 - conditional-marker clitic 'by' has similar placement rules, but slightly less strict rightadjacency

affix or clitic?

Past tense agreement marker: Affix or clitic?

Left of verb... clitic!

- no morphophonological integration
- wide scope over coordination
- must be to the left of all pronominal clitics

Right Adjacent... affix!

- morphophonological integration with host
- no wide scope over coordination
- there can be pronominal clitics to the left of the host

'by' conditional-marker displays clitic-like behaviour in both positions

HPSG analysis

- treat past tense agreement marker as morphosyntactic hybrid
- past tense verbs can contribute more than one domain object to linear domain structure
- morphological rules introduce exponents of agreement on verbal host
- ...yet the lexically-introduced phonology will be mapped to other domain object
