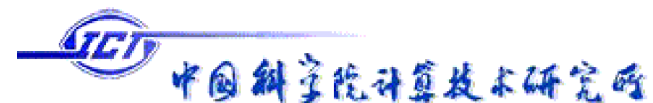

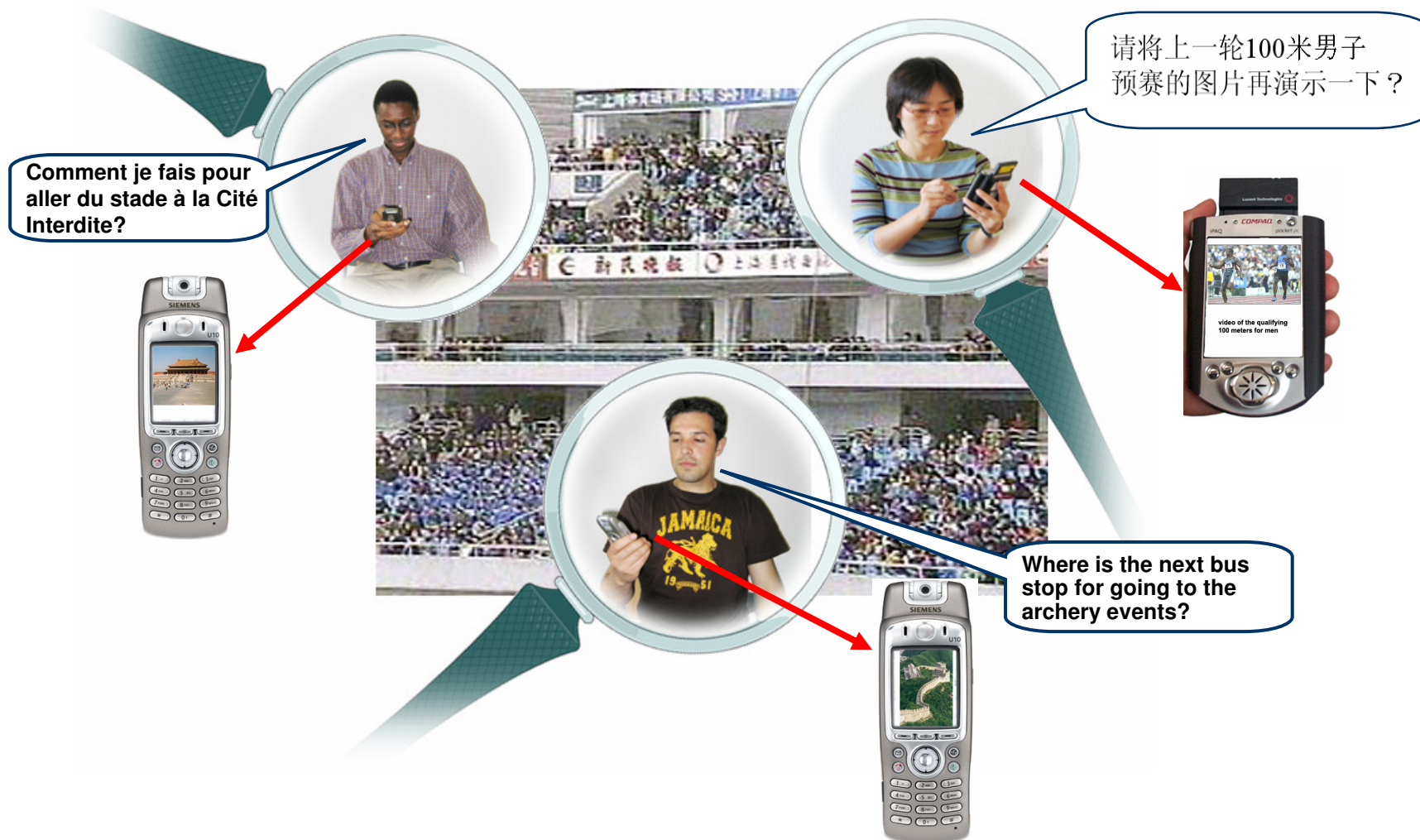

Improvements

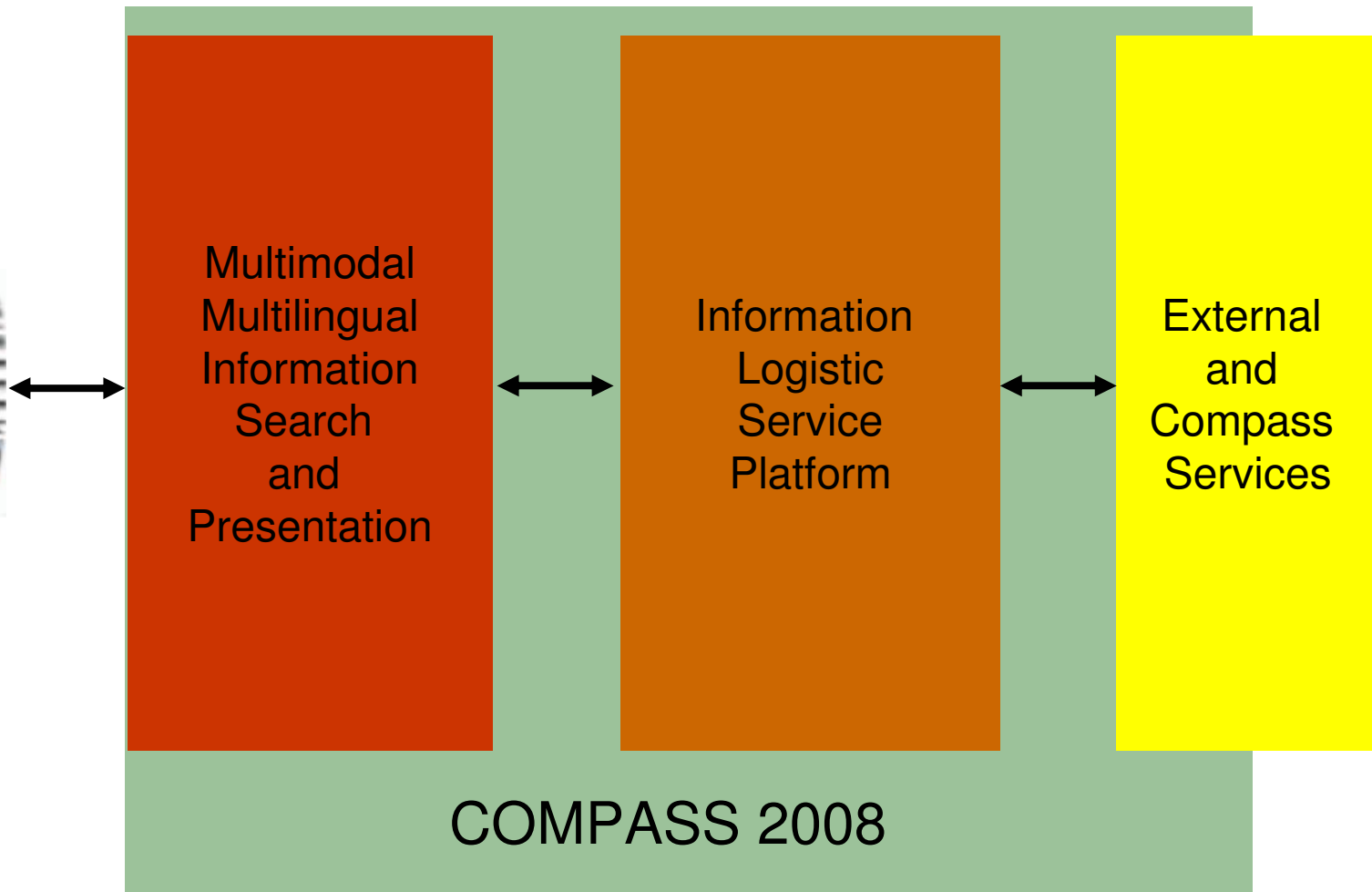


- Simple phrasebooks, calculator, paper based information is not really acceptable.
