**No participation with positive tests or symptoms**

- You must not sit the exam if you are currently tested positive or have symptoms.
- In this case or if symptoms show after the registration deadline, please inform the examination office ([exam-office@coli.uni-saarland.de](mailto:exam-office@coli.uni-saarland.de)) **\*immediately\*** (on the day of the exam at the latest) of the fact that you have symptoms that may indicate an infection with SARS-CoV-2 („Corona“) and that you are unable to sit the exam.
- This will be treated as “withdrawal without failing” even without a medical certificate, and non-attendance will not be registered as failure. In this case sitting the exam again is possible..

**Further corona-related and practical instructions**

- Please arrive at the building and lecture hall **15 minutes before the exam** is scheduled to start.
- Please wear masks and keep the distance. You are not required to wear a mask during the exam.
- Enter the lecture hall and sit down in one of the marked seats, starting from the middle of the row rather than from the edges.
- Place your Uds card visibly on the desk.
- We will check you off on the list of registered participants and hand out the exam questions.
- Upon completing the exam, you may leave the room, but starting from the edges. You may have to wait for your neighbors to leave, until you can get out without violating the distancing rule.
- You must **hand in your exam sheets before leaving the room**.
- You only need a pen; everything else, including spare paper, will be provided.
