


# Follow-up

  - Positioning of objects
  - Gaze cue neutrality
- Robustness of effects




# Differences to experiment II

#### Design:

- 72 experimental trials / 72 filler
- Cross-wise positioning of objects
- Static empty position (below face)
- Neutral gaze cue -> downward gaze
- 3 experimental conditions


#### **Distribution of gaze actions**

	EXP I	EXP 2
C	<b>70</b> %	58.3%
I	12%	16.6%
N	18%	25%




Incongruent

## Results (second noun onset)

\*Full = 150-450ms time-window

Lack of significant difference between the N2 and N4 time-window indicates two distinct effects

Congruent (black) - Incongruent (red) - Neutral (blue)
