Praat Scripting 08 Picture Window

The Picture Window is one of the two main windows in Praat (usually the one that you normally close after opening Praat). Below are the most important commands listed to use within the Picture Window.

File \rightarrow Save as PDF file Saves the <u>selected</u> area as a PDF file Save as PNG file Saves the <u>selected</u> area as a PNG file Save as EPS file Saves the selected area as a EPS file Edit \rightarrow Erase all Erases all your drawings (similar to clearinfo) Margins \rightarrow Draw inner box Draws a rectangle inside the drawing area Text left/right/top/bottom Write text into the margins around the drawing area Marks left/right/top/bottom Draw a number of equally spaced marks One mark left/right/top/bottom Draw one mark Marks left/right/top/bottom Draw any number of equally spaced marks Change the current world coordinates of the horizontal/vertical axes Axes World \rightarrow

Text	Write text inside the drawing area
Text special	Write text inside the drawing area, modify font, font size, and rotation
Draw line/arrow	Draw a line/arrow at a specific location
Draw rectangle/ellipse/circle	Draw a rectangle/ellipse/circle
Paint rectangle/ellipse/circle	Paint a rectangle/ellipse/circle (filled with color)

Select inner viewport	Determines the drawing area, does not include margins
Select outer viewport	Determines the drawing area, includes margins
Viewport text	Write text inside the viewport at nine different places

Font \rightarrow

Changes the appearance of the drawn lines Changes the width of the drawn lines Changes color (text, lines, etc.)
