

Praat Scripting

Exercise 05

1. Write a script that creates a form that gives the user the possibility to choose between
 - a) different tiers of a TextGrid (default settings: first tier)
 - b) a different number of calculated formants (default settings: two formants)
2. Include an error message that stops the execution of the script if the user chooses a tier number that does not exist in the TextGrid. In order to do that you have to use the argument **exit**. For more information see the Praat user manual §6.8 *Messages to the user*.
3. Keep in mind the header of your created output. The information about the number of formants needs to change according to the selection of the user.
For example:
two formants → File Name Label Duration F1(Hz) F2(Hz)
three formants → File Name Label Duration F1(Hz) F2(Hz) F3(Hz)
