## Praat Scripting Exercise 05

- 1. Write a script that creates a form that gives the user the possibility to choose between
  - a) different tiers of a TextGrid (default settings: first tier)
  - b) a different number of calculated formants (default settings: two formants)
- 2. Include an error message that stops the execution of the script if the user chooses a tier number that does not exist in the TextGrid. In order to do that you have to use the argument exit. For more information see the Praat user manual §6.8 Messages to the user.
- 3. Keep in mind the header of your created output. The information about the number of formants needs to change according to the selection of the user. For example:

two formants  $\rightarrow$  File Name Label Duration F1(Hz) F2(Hz) three formants  $\rightarrow$  File Name Label Duration F1(Hz) F2(Hz) F3(Hz)
